NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

Scholarship recipients must be enrolled as a full-time student in the fall semester immediately following graduation in an accredited institute of higher learning during the regular school year (Fall-Spring). There can be no decline in full time status during the regular school year. If an educational facility considers less than (12) twelve hours a full load the scholarship committee must have written documentation for that institute.

Payment will be made directly to the scholarship recipient in form of check. To receive payment for the upcoming semester the recipient must provide proof of registration.

Please follow instructions carefully and check your application to ensure that you have included all required documents and information.

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a graduating senior.
- Applicant must declare they will be attending college or trade school on application.
- Applicant must be a member in good standing in 4-H or FFA.
- Applicant must compete in the 2025 Texas Youth Expo.
 - Or have previously exhibited at the Texas Youth Expo.
- Applicant must submit an unofficial copy of current high school transcript.
- Applicant must submit one letter of reference.
- Applicant must submit an essay of at least five hundred (500) typed words answering ONE of the following topics:
 - Technology has an increasingly greater role in the agriculture industry, do you believe technological advances can replace traditional methods of farm and livestock management?
 - Discuss in depth advantages and disadvantages of the impact online marketing and live bid sales have had on the livestock industry.
 - Thinking about the advanced skills you have developed through your projects, how can these skills be applied to future improve methods of production in agricultural industries?
